Dear Family Member, Resident Representative,

We are very pleased to announce that Warren Haven has been cleared by the Warren County and New Jersey Department of Health of their COVID-19 Outbreak status. This means the facility has not had any new positive COVID-19 cases in 28 days. During this past outbreak, the facility had a total of 5 staff member test positive. We are very grateful that no residents tested positive during this time. We certainly contribute this feat to our hardworking dedicated staff who continue to put the safety of the residents of Warren Haven first.

In the coming days, we will begin to restart the facilities Re-Opening plan. This will include small group activities, small group dining and outdoor visitation. During these programs residents will still need to remain masked and 6 feet apart to meet the guidelines. We understand outdoor visitation may not be feasible for all during these cold and snowy days so we remind all that our Virtual Visits may be scheduled at any time by notifying our receptionist.

Unfortunately, indoor visitation is still curtailed according to New Jersey Department of Health due to the COVID-19 activity level continuing to be in the high range with the state. <https://www.nj.gov/health/cd/statistics/covid/index.shtml>. These restrictions will remain in place until the state changes to moderate or low level. We will notify you when these restrictions are lifted.
