Dear Family Member, Resident Representative,

On Wednesday, March 3, 2021 Warren Haven was informed that one direct care staff member has tested positive for COVID-19. Due to this positive result the facility has reverted back to Phase 0 in the NJ guidelines for reopening and as a safety precaution we are treating all residents as Persons Under Investigation for COVID-19. The New Jersey Department of Health has moved the facility to an "Investigation Status" until further testing of both residents and staff is completed.

Warren Haven is continuing to work collaboratively under the guidance of the Warren County and New Jersey Department of Health ("DOH"). Warren Haven is taking all precautions to safeguard the residents and staff of the facility. This will include implementing transmission based precautions and testing all residents weekly for at least the next 14 days to ensure that they are not infected. We continue to test all employees twice a week and remain vigilant in our surveillance and the education we provide to all of staff.
